



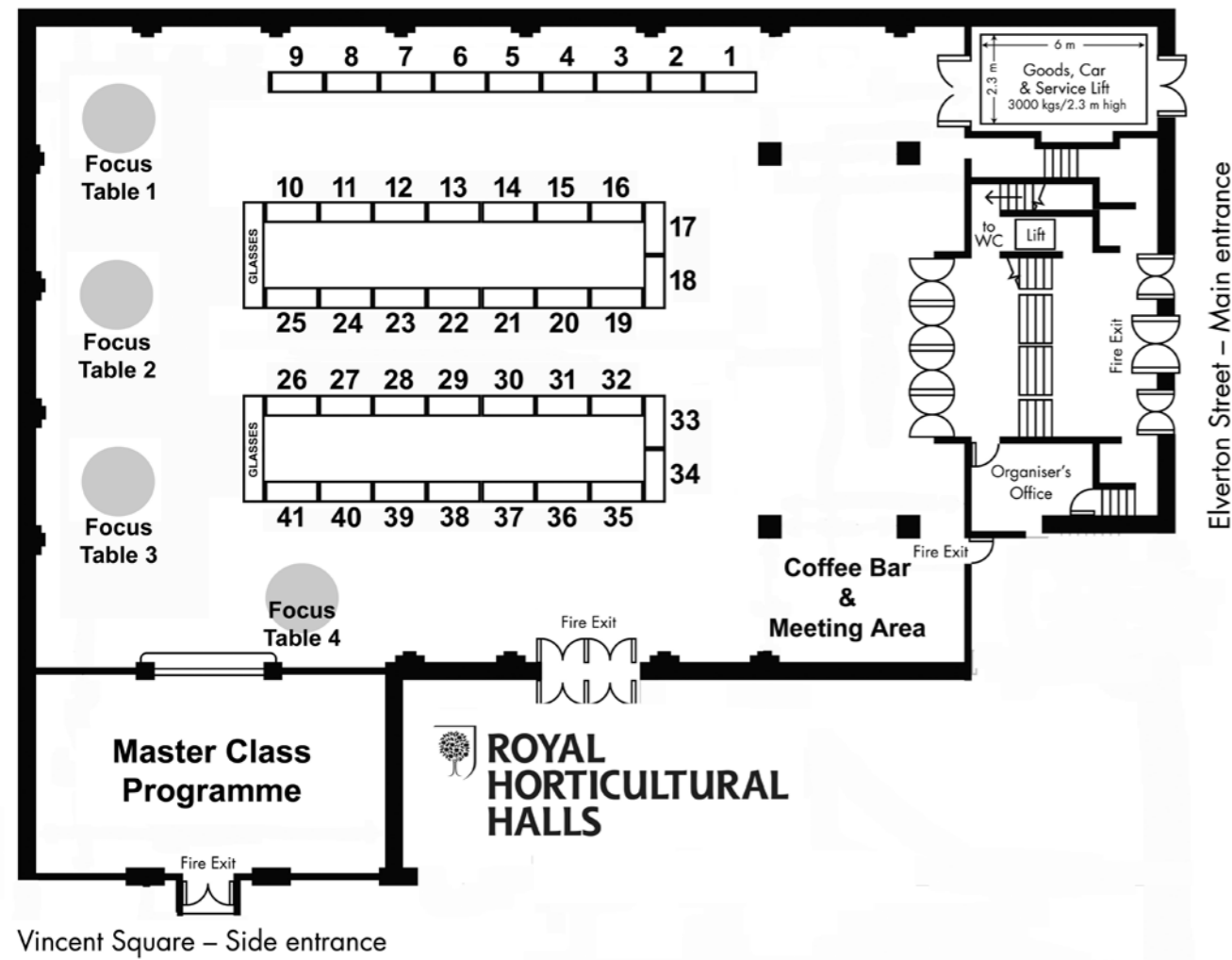

Thanks to its work, in 1969 Prosecco di Conegliano Valdobbiadene was granted DOC status and in 2009 became a DOCG, bearing the name of Conegliano Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore. DOCG conferral is the territory's seal of approval as the finest expression of Prosecco.

The Conegliano Valdobbiadene district covers 15 communities in the Treviso Prealps foothills. The denomination's vineyards cover over 7,000 hectares and yearly production of Conegliano Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore amounts to some 83,000,000 bottles.

The consortium's role is primarily to protect Conegliano Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore and to provide technical assistance to producers in vineyard and cellar so that quality is constantly enhanced. The tutelary consortium also promotes better knowledge of the product in Italy and abroad through events, educational work and relations with the press. Finally, its Studies Centre monitors the market for Conegliano Valdobbiadene.
